Safety & Security in Amwaj

The security department would like to remind our valued residents once again of the importance of placing the Amwaj resident sticker on your cars. This is to help the security department control and ease traffic coming into Amwaj Islands, especially during holiday season, and help identify Amwaj residents.

If you have not received one yet, please contact the security department—or drop by the security office, which is open Sunday to Thursday from 8am to 5pm, to arrange for your car pass. You will need to bring a copy of your homes ownership deed, or rental contract if you are renting, as well as a copy of your ID card and your car's license plate number. The security office is located on the left hand side of the Amwaj (Ossis) main office, at the entrance of Amwaj Islands.

For the safety of the Amwaj Islands community, please adhere to the 40km/hr speed limit. If you would like a copy of the Amwaj Islands rules & regulations, kindly send an email to info@amwaj.bh

Motor boats and jet skis are not allowed in areas designated for swimming. The only exception is for motor boats powered by an electric motor not exceeding 5hp. The maximum permitted speed is 3 knots.

Jet ski owners have to submit a picture of their jet ski along with the owner's address in Amwaj to the security department. Boat owners must submit a copy of their boat's registration.
