**Due to increasing traffic violations in Amwaj Islands, we are currently implementing new traffic arrangements to ensure compliance with driving safety and speed regulations. We kindly ask for your cooperation in making Amwaj Islands and its roads a safe place to be in.**

**Jet ski owners have to submit a picture of their jet ski along with the owner's address in Amwaj to the Security Department. Boat owners must submit a copy of their boat's registration. Motor boats and jetskis are not allowed in areas designated for swimming. The only exception is for motor boats powered by an electric motor not exceeding 5hp. The maximum permitted speed is 3 knots.**

## Recipe of the Month

### Oatmeal Pancakes:

**A great healthy recipe, that your kids can help with..**

These pancakes are comforting and filling. Try adding chopped nuts or dried fruit for a special treat.

#### Ingredients

- 2 eggs
- 2 tbsp. vegetable oil
- 1 cup all-purpose flour, or 1/2 cup all-purpose and 1/2 cup whole wheat
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 3/4 cup orange juice (preferably fresh)
- 1/2 cup chopped nuts or fruit (optional)
- 2 tbsp. butter

#### Instructions

1. In a small bowl, mix the eggs with the oil.
2. In a medium-size bowl, combine the dry ingredients.
3. Stir the egg mixture into the dry ingredients, then stir in enough orange juice to create a thick batter. Add chopped nuts or dried fruit, such as apricots, if desired.
4. Heat the butter in a large frying pan, then pour batter into the pan by quarter cupfuls. Cook until done, turning once.

Makes 9 medium-size pancakes.

**Tips:** Your kids can enjoy cooking this meal with you, big kids can measure the ingredients into a bowl, and small ones can stir to their heart's content (the recipe can't be ruined by too much stirring).
